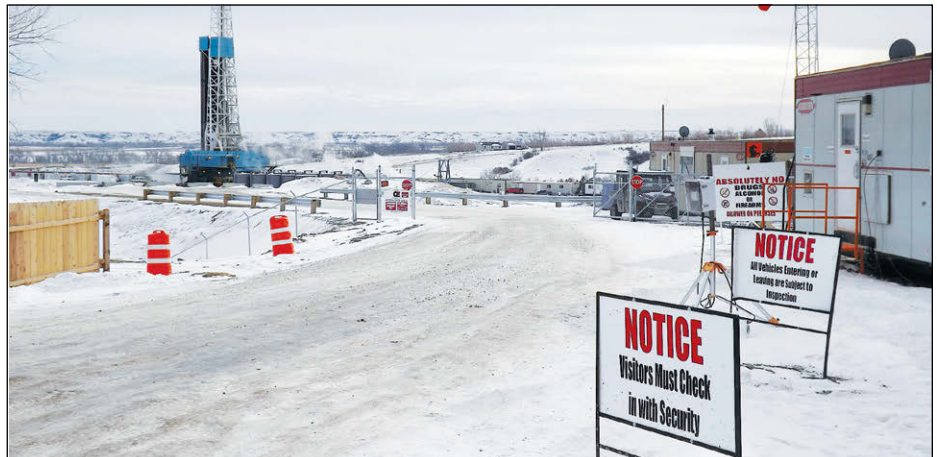
“Show Piece” Electric Rig Drilling

As the largest operator in the Williston Basin, Continental Resources has a reputation for a lot of firsts in drilling and production.

Now they are the first operator to use electricity to power Cyclone Rig #2 on a unique multi-pad location, Atlanta 1-6H, just off Hwy. 85 on the western edge of Williston, ND. The project is also unique in other ways.

Working with Mountrail Williams Electric, workers installed an overhead dedicated loop line from a nearby substation. Using an average

PAW Opposes Seismic Fee Legislation

Legislation that proposes fee and compliance changes for seismographic work faces opposition from the Petroleum Assn. of Wyoming.

Bruce Hinchey, president of PAW, said that regulation of seismic work would remain under the responsibility of the Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission. The commission is better able to determine fees for seismic work, he said.

HB 16 introduced into the Wyoming State legislature proposed that fees of \$5,000 for the first 1,000 acres and additional fees of \$1,000 for each subsequent 1,000 acres be levied to protect surface owners.

In addition, a surety bond for seismic operations could only be accepted by the oil and gas operator who has leased the land, and the bill bans any seismic operations for those who do not have a lease.

A hearing had not been set by the Legislature, which started its session Jan. 8 and meets for 40 days.

WY Oil Leases Sold To Trust

Oil and gas leases on 58,000 acres in Wyoming's Hoback Basin held by Plains Exploration & Production Co. of Houston were acquired for \$8.5 million by the Trust for Public Lands.

More than 1,000 people and organizations contributed to the effort including a last minute contribution of \$750,000 by philanthropist Joe Rickets.

The fund raising effort was started to save the area inside the Bridger-Teton National Forest for its natural beauty, hunting and fishing and also includes the headwaters of the Hoback River.

The Wyoming Range Legacy Act provides that oil and gas leases can be permanently retired when they are bought out instead of being sold to other oil companies. "This solution honors the wishes of the people of Wyoming and protects a vital corner of Greater Yellowstone for generations to come," said Will Rogers, president and CEO of TPL.

Coalition Focuses on Cleanup Plan After ND Well Blowout

A coalition of local and state agencies is working with Newfield Exploration Co. of Houston on a cleanup plan on a North Dakota oil well blowout where high winds whipped oil and salt water over a two-mile area of farmland.

Crews have scraped up oil soaked snow off roads and fields and have taken it to authorized disposal areas.

Environmental consultants from Santec are evaluating conditions on the ground where most of the fluids remained on top of snow-covered fields. Newfield is working with the ND Dept. of Mineral Resources, ND Dept. of Health, Environmental Protection Agency, and local agencies to develop a cleanup strategy.

On Jan. 2, crews were on location cleaning up the workover rig and other equipment.

Newfield brought the Drovdal 150-99-18-19-1H well in Sec. 7, T150N-R99W in McKenzie County under control on Dec. 23 and plugged it Dec. 24 after injecting salt water that killed the well.

It spewed an estimated 1,400 barrels of oil, 740 barrels of saltwater and 2.2 million cubic feet of natural gas over a 48-hour period.

Keith Schmidt, a spokesperson for Newfield, said it appears that the blowout was caused by a "mechanical failure of the well tubing" resulting in losing control over the well. The fluids sprayed about 95 feet into the air and were carried over a two-mile area by high winds for a 48-hour time period.

Newfield is working with landowners in the area to make sure the area is restored to a "safe and healthy environment", Schmidt said.

According to Kris Roberts, a field inspector for the ND Health Dept., a workover crew lost control of the well when they were completing it and well pressure blew oil and saltwater about 95 feet into the air.

Denbury Moves CO2 To MT Field

Denbury Resources of Plano, TX said it expects to start receiving up to 115 Mmcf of CO2 a day from ExxonMobil's LaBarge plant, which will be fed into a 20-inch pipeline, running 232 miles from Wyoming to the Bell Creek Oil Field in southeast Montana.



Denbury will pay ExxonMobil a fee for the carbon dioxide, which will also be used in secondary recovery in Wyoming oilfields. The company just closed in December on a \$1.3 billion sale of its Bakken area assets to ExxonMobil, and Denbury retains at 17.5% interest.

The carbon dioxide source allows Denbury to accelerate its planned CO2 flood of Hartzog Draw Field in Wyoming.

MT Board Presses Hunt For Missing Mineral Owners

The Montana Board of Oil and Gas Conservation wants to make sure that all efforts have been made to locate mineral owners as they debated new rules on forced pooling that will be acted on in February.

In December, they discussed a proposal drafted by attorney Brent D. Chicken, who outlined new guidelines for operators on their attempts to seek participation from mineral owners in the drilling of a well and the "reasonableness" of those offers.

The proposed rules grew out of the board's concern at an earlier meeting on oil company efforts to contact mineral owners.

Board member Ronald Efta in December said that some companies use the threat of force pooling to make people sign "less than favorable leases".

He favors North Dakota state rules that provide for imposing a risk penalty if the operator contacts the owner in writing by mail with a required receipt signature and offers both an invitation to participate in the well and a good faith offer to lease. He also likes North Dakota's 50% risk penalty.

Chicken pointed out that current Montana regulations state that a "good faith effort" must be made to voluntarily pool all interests in the drilling of a well. Most companies make that effort but Chicken agrees with the board over their concerns on finding "unlocatable owners".

Attorney Don Lee said most of the companies he represents make a "very diligent effort" to find mineral owners beyond what the law requires. Lee suggested that if the board takes action to help mineral owners in the eastern counties, it could have an "adverse effect on Toole, Glacier, Pondera and Teton counties.

Attorney John Lee said companies should be rewarded for risking their capital because Bakken wells are not always a sure thing. "Mineral owners want no risk and all the reward," he said.

Larry Tveit, a former state senator, said the board should not be in the business of telling companies what is a reasonable effort and negotiating leases. Mineral owners should get information they need from the royalty owners associations, he said.

Dennis Trudell, president of the northeast Montana Land and Mineral Owners Assn., said mineral owners often get a letter telling them to send in payment or lease or they would be force-pooled.

Often the lease offer is "unreasonable", Trudell said, and mineral owners do not understand force pooling and risk penalties.

Under Chicken's proposal, operators would be required to state that a voluntary pooling offer was sent to each mineral owner in a spacing unit.

Whiting Forecasts 209,000 EUR From Sheridan Well

Whiting Oil and Gas Corp. of Denver estimated initial production from horizontal wells it is drilling in Montana's Sheridan County would have an initial production rate of 200 BOPD and an ultimate recovery of 209,000 barrels.

At a hearing before the Montana Board of Oil and Gas Conservation in Billings in December, Whiting asked for approval of 1280-acre permanent spacing in section 25 & 36, T31N-R55E where it has drilled the Cronlie Farms #31-25H at a cost of \$8 million.

In Richland County, it asked for permanent 1280-acre spacing for the Iverson Bros #14-33H well in sections 28 & 33, T26N-R58E. The initial production was 650 BOPD and expected EUR was 336,000 barrels of oil with an expected net revenue of \$22.1 million.

The company also asked for approval to drill three Bakken additional wells in sections 27 & 33, T26N-R58E.

Two years ago, the Western Area Water Supply Authority was just getting started with \$110 million in loans from the ND State Legislature. With the Williston city water plant as the hub source, it is now feeding cleaned up Missouri River water into Watford City, Alexander, Williams County and north into Divide County. **Because of population projections, raising the number of people from 35,000 to 90,000 by 2025, WAWS wants more money.** It will be asking state legislators this month for another \$120 million in loans for 2013-2015. Expenditures include expanding the Williston plant from 14 million to 21 million gallons a day at \$27 million; building pump stations, reservoirs and transmission lines for \$49 million; and distribution lines for \$44 million. It has nine water depots that are in operation now and another six that will be built or planned. **Total water depot output is 10.4 million barrels of water when they are all built.** This agency has been banking on the oil industry using water depots to pay for a lot of the capital expenditures. Bismarck attorney Bob Harms, who represents the private

Continental Wraps Tight Security on Electric Rig

1.5 megawatts a day, that line will power that rig for the next 270 days for the drilling of 14 horizontal wells in sunburst pattern under the Missouri River.

Continental estimates it is saving \$2,000 a day being on the electrical power grid instead of diesel fuel-powered engines.

"This is a show piece. We were very interested in this project and watching it go," said Dale Haugen, general manager of Mountrail-Williams. "I feel a lot more comfortable putting it out on new lines."

Continental is using a transformer supplied by Electric Drilling Technologies of Dallas to feed electricity to the rig motors and powering other ancillary services including the permanent housing for the toolpusher, company hand, and geologist.

"We are tracking the power we are using and at different times of the day," said Kyle Davis, a drilling engineer for Continental.

The system reduces noise and that is an important aspect because the location is close to businesses and homes.

The operator is prepared to fall back on its diesel generators in case of a power failure, according to Davis.

"We are hoping to improve on our operating costs," said Alan McNally with Continental. Eliminating diesel fuel, which runs about 1500 to 2,000 gallons a day, is resulting in lower emissions.

The 20-acre location is completely fenced and employs offsite security and surveillance cameras. Arctic supplies 24/7 hot meal service to the permanent employees on location.

Every person coming on the location is checked in and given a safety orientation. "It is important for us to know who is coming on and for what reason," Davis said.

The high performing Cyclone "walking rig" is being used for "batch drilling" of four holes and then will be moved to the next set.

The location is also unique because more than 360,000 cubic yards of dirt were used to build it, compared to 6,000 yards for

a regular pad. Water pipelines were brought into the location, reducing truck traffic and produced oil and gas will also be fed into an internal pipeline system.

EDT Touts Cost Savings in Texas

Electric Drilling Technologies of Dallas, which is providing the transformer unit to Continental Resources for the first electric rig drilling program in the Williston Basin, said the net savings on a single well in the Barnett Shale near Arlington where its unit was used saved \$42,855.

The transformer was used because the area was near a car manufacturing plant and housing. Nearby utility lines made installation and hookup easy to accomplish.

Over the 15 days of drilling time, the total cost for drilling was \$35,895, compared to using diesel fuel, which would have cost \$78,750 over the same time period, the company said. Overall, 15 wells were drilled on the location resulting in a total savings of \$642,825 for using electricity.

Seaway Pipeline Starts Up

Completion the of the 500-mile Seaway Pipeline this month from Cushing, OK to the Texas Gulf Coast is expected to have a positive impact on lowering West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude oil prices.

Seaway Crude Oil Pipeline Co. LLC of Houston said the final work on the line will increase capacity by 150,000 BOPD to 400,000 BOPD. Work involved completing the pump station connections on the 30-inch pipeline.

Seaway is a 50-50 joint venture with Enterprise Products Partners and Enbridge Inc. the project includes a terminal and distribution network at Texas City serving Houston area refineries.

Fixed Backyards Hop On Williston Basin Pads

“Fixed Backyards”—while not new to the oil and gas industry—are fast becoming a growing trend on Williston Basin pad wells.

Leading the way are Nabors Drilling, the largest drilling contractor, and Continental Resources, the biggest operator.

There are economic and environmental advantages to this system, according to Dennis A. Smith, director of corporate and investor relations for Nabors. Of the 52 rigs drilling in North Dakota and Montana, at least 30 are working on pads using fixed backyards, he said.

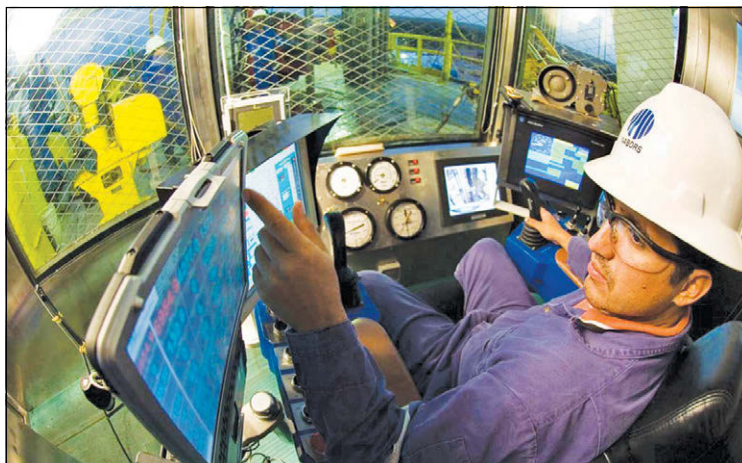
With this system, all tanks, fluids handling, and pipe racks, remain stationary in one spot on the pad location. Normally, after drilling a set of four wells, these would all be moved to the next set of four holes.

Those tanks and fluids units for drilling mud and salt water are connected by “umbilical flow lines” that move on a hydraulic extension tray as the rig and derrick are moved up to the next set of holes, said Kyle Davis, drilling engineer for Continental.

The flow lines can extend as far as 125 feet and Continental is looking at stretching them as far as 800 feet.

Horizontal drilling lends itself to a centralized pad that has a lot of benefits, Smith said. “It is much more efficient.”

“Costs have risen dramatically in the Bakken,” Smith said. “This has led customers to seek ways to reduce costs and reduce environmental impact.”

Instead of having to move a rig each time, the \$20 million unit can “walk” to the next location just a few feet away from the hole that it was just drilling.

The centralized pad and fixed backyard means a lot less equipment on location, less truck traffic and less remediation work after the drilling is completed, Smith said.

Ron Ness, president of the ND Petroleum Council, said that pad drilling reduces impacts on the land. “Because fewer trucks and rig fleets are needed to move and assemble equipment on several separate well pads,” Ness said, “multi-well pads and horizontal drilling are also helping reduce the impact to roads and infrastructure.”

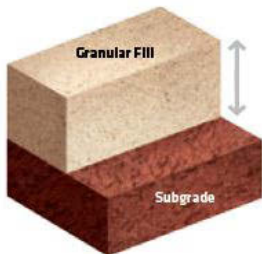

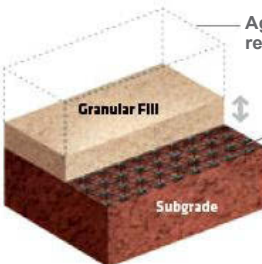

Because traders were expecting higher inventories to be announced, West Texas Intermediate (WTI) oil prices on the New York Mercantile Exchange dropped 42 cents to \$92.75 a barrel for February delivery during early trading Jan. 8.. Brent crude was up 13 cents to \$111.54.

Oil stockpiles went up by 0.6% to 362 million barrels in the seven days ending Jan. 4, according to a survey of analysts by Bloomberg.

"The bearish factor is that there is an expectation that inventories will rise, analyst Phil Flynn with Price Futures Group in Chicago told Bloomberg. "Crude is probably going to be building over the next coming weeks."

Barrett Cuts 2013 Capital Spending

Bill Barrett Corp. dropped by \$400 million its capital spending program for 2013 as it focuses more on oil drilling in Utah and Colorado.

The company said it will spend between \$475 million and \$525 million to drill 150 gross operated wells with four rigs in its Uinta Basin holdings, two rigs in the DJ Basin and will only drill five low-risk development oil wells in Wyoming's Powder River Basin.

"We have two high-quality oil programs and can now turn our focus to developing the excellent assets and inventory that we have established," said Fred Barrett, chairman, president and CEO. "We are implementing a prudent capital expenditure program focused on realizing value from our core oil development assets, and we are dedicated to managing our debt levels."

For 2013, the company estimates production will range between 83 and 87 Bcfe, and this year it expects NGLs (natural gas liquids) to be 6% of total production volumes.

Vanguard Finalizes Barrett Acquisitions

Vanguard Natural Resources LLC closed its acquisition of oil and gas producing assets on 250,000 acres in Wyoming's Powder River Basin for \$328.8 million on Dec. 31 from Bill Barrett Corp. of Denver.

The current net production is 65 Mmcfe a day (85% natural gas) from 2,822 gross wells, and Vanguard financed the acquisition from its existing reserve-based credit facility.

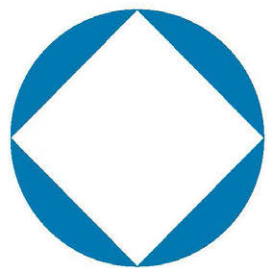

Basic Pays \$43 Million For ND Disposal Units

Basic Energy Services of Ft. Worth, TX, which has service centers in the Williston Basin, bought five salt water disposal plants from Saltwater Disposal of North Dakota LLC for \$43 million. The acquisition also includes eight homes.

Located in Mountrail County, ND, Basic estimates 2013 revenue from these disposal plants will be an estimated \$14 million.

“These facilities augment our existing fluid services operations in the area and anchor the expansion of our integrated fluid services capabilities in a large and growing portion of the Bakken shale market,” said Basic’s President and CEO Ken Huseman. “We look forward to the SWDND management team’s guidance as we continue to build our salt water disposal capabilities in the Bakken.”

Basic employs 5,000 employees and has 100 service centers in 13 states.

Fidelity Asks For MT Spacing

At a December hearing before the Montana Board of Oil and Gas Conservation in Billings, Fidelity Exploration & Production Co. of Denver sought approval for several spacing actions.

In Rosebud County, Fidelity estimated it could recover 69,000 barrels of oil and 144,697 Mcf of gas from the Ranch 44-1H well in Sec. 1, T10N-R34E that cost \$4 million to drill. It asked for approval of 640-acre spacing.

In Richland County, Fidelity asked for approval of 640-acre spacing for the Klose #8-17H well in Sec. 8, T22N-R57E. The well cost \$7 million and has an expected ultimate recovery of 168,000 barrels of oil.

It also asked for 640-acre spacing for the Lisa #22-23H well in Sec. 22, T22N-R57E and approval to drill three more horizontal wells in the same location.

Colorado Road Impact Fees Weighed

Colorado's Boulder County is drafting regulations that would impose an impact fee for road use by oil service companies after a consultant called for fees of \$1,200 for a well pad and \$36,900 for each well on the pad.

The county commissioners have taken no formal action.

County commissioners said they are concerned about wear and tear on roads after a report said road repairs could total as much as \$27.6 million.

BBC Research and Consultants said that most of the traffic would be trucks traveling back and forth to a well location. A water truck could have a load impact ranging 5,500 to 11,000 times that of a passenger car and a semi truck would be 20,000 to 30,000 times, the consultant said.

COGA Rips Into New Water Sampling Rules

The Colorado Oil and Gas Assn. sharply criticized as "excessive" new ground water sampling rules adopted Jan. 7 by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.

The regulations require water samples to be taken from up to four nearby water wells within half mile of an oil and gas well location. It also requires samples to be taken from the same water wells between six and twelve months after the oil or gas well is drilling and again between five and six years following the well drilling.

COGA backed a voluntary program, in which over 93% of the operators supported. "If this program would have been converted to a mandatory program" said COGA spokesman Doug Flanders, "it would have been one of the most comprehensive water programs in the country, significantly exceeding many other water sampling requirements in the country in both scientific rigor and transparency."

The new rule should have built off the successes of the voluntary groundwater monitoring "without unnecessarily hampering energy development with excessive and unnecessary requirements", Flanders said.

COGA backed a program that sampled three wells up to a half mile from the well location and included sampling before and after the well was drilled.

"This new set of groundwater monitoring rules once again puts Colorado in the forefront of thoughtful and progressive regulatory oversight of energy development," said Matt Lepore, director of the commission.

"This rule represents a strong proactive step to monitor and protect our groundwater and is right for Colorado," said Commissioner Andy Spielman. "We have once again set the bar high in our assertive and judicious regulatory approach to oil and gas development."

In the Grater Wattenberg Area of northeastern Colorado, operators will be required to sample one water well per quarter section before and after drilling.

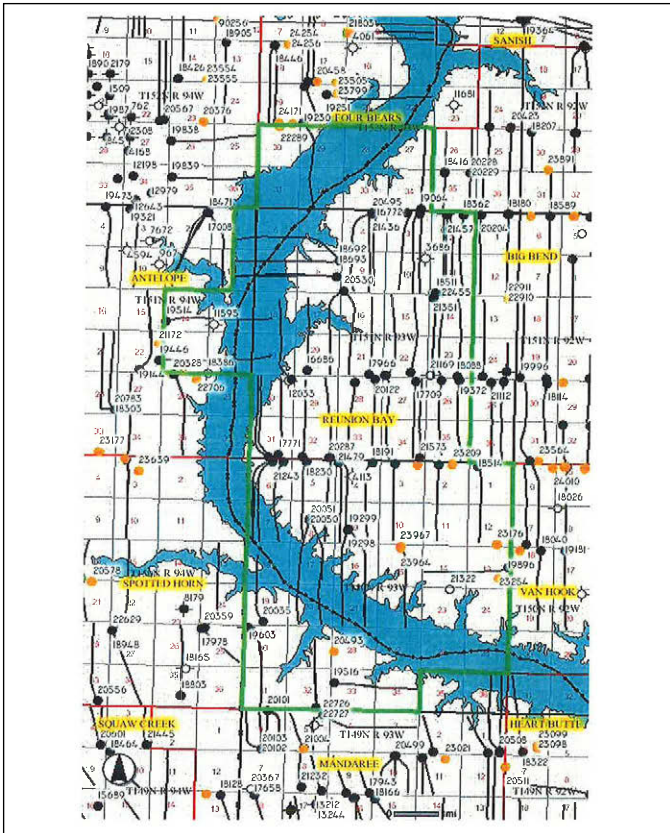
The state program will run alongside a testing program developed by Weld County, which requires water well testing from any land owner who asks for it.

QEP Plans MLP For Rockies Midstream

QEP Resources, Inc. of Denver said it is bundling up its midstream assets in Wyoming and North Dakota into a master limited partnership, from which it expects to raise \$300 million to \$400 million from the initial public offering.

Proceeds from the IPO scheduled for the second quarter of this year will be used to repay debt and for general corporate expenses.

QEP, which has an active drilling program in the Williston Basin, will contribute to the MLP initially and then sell a minority interest in it.



WPX Energy asked the ND Industrial Commission in December to allow the unlimited flaring of several oil wells in the marked Reunion Bay area on Lake Sakakawea—some until June because connecting to a gas line is uneconomical at this time.

Abraxas Cites Delays On ND Oil Wells

Abraxas Petroleum Corp. of San Antonio, TX said it was disappointed with delays on a McKenzie County well which had been due to be completed in December.

“Although we are disappointed with the completion delays in the Bakken,” said President and CEO Bob Watson, “operations continue to perform exceptionally well at Abraxas with well results and efficiency gains in our Bakken drilling program.”

The delay occurred on the Lililbridge 20-17H pad in Sec. 20, T150N-R96W when there was downhole equipment failure. Remediation work on the Raven 2H, in which Abraxas has a 49% working interest, is continuing and a revised simulation is set for later this month.

According to Abraxas, the Raven 3H on the same pad in which the company also has a 49% working interest, also experienced mechanical problems and it will be completed in mid-February.

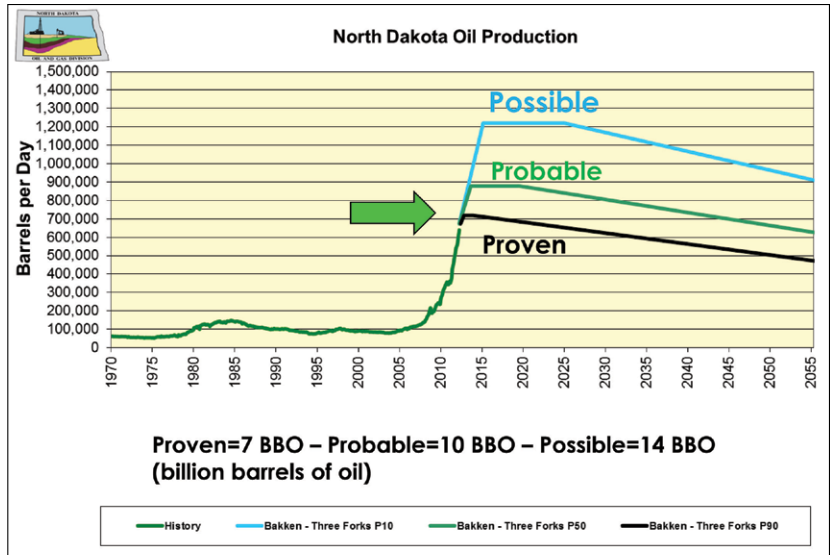
Derek Uses Steam For WY Wells

EOG Banks On Big Mountrail Drilling Plan

EOG Resources of Houston will spend an estimated \$143 million to drill two dozen Bakken and Three Forks wells in North Dakota's Mountrail County, company officials said.

At a Dec. 20 hearing before the ND Industrial Commission, EOG estimated each of the wells would have an ultimate recovery of 590,000 barrels of oil.

It asked for approval of two overlapping 1920-acre spacing units, each with three wells, in sections 3, 4, 10, 5, 6 7 8, T155N-R90W. It also wanted approval of two overlapping 1280-cre spacing units in sections 22, 27, 30 & 31, T155N-R90W and two overlapping 1920-acre spacing units in sections 20, 21, 28 & 29, T155N-R90W, with each overlapping unit also having three wells.

In other business American Eagle Corp. of Littleton, CO asked for approval to drill eight wells in each of the 800-acre standup spacing units in Divide County in sections 29 & 32, 30 & 31, T164N-R101W.

The company estimated it would cost \$5.9 million to drill each well, which would have an initial production rate of 325 BOPD and produce a net income of \$16.2 million.

American Eagle just received Jan. 2 \$16 million from Macquarie Bank Ltd. for its North Dakota drilling program.

"This funding transaction provides an important source of capital that allows American eagle to continue its aggressive development pace in Spyglass, which we expect will significantly expand our production and reserve base," said President Brad Colby.

water suppliers in western North Dakota and is also president of the ND Taxpayers Assn., says it's time to take a step and scrutinize spending. **Harms said he is "offended" by the fact that WAWS has already paid out \$10 million in fees to the consulting engineer, AES Engineers, and another \$500,000 to the Vogel law firm.** In addition, a major North Dakota contractor told him it was not allowed to bid on WAWS construction projects because of the "compressed time frame". When the bidding time is shortened, then it results in higher bids and eliminates some ND contractors, according to Harms. **We have already seen huge cost overruns so when it comes time for public hearings before the State Legislature this month, we hope there will be a lot of questions asked on WAWS spending habits.** It is already clear that private water users are supplying the oil industry with more than enough water now and, WAWS is pushing back against companies that want permits to take water out of the Missouri River in McKenzie County. **Companies such as Oasis Petroleum and Statoil have developed their own internal water systems that feed their network of well locations, and that eliminates the need for WAWS water services.** Harms said there are applications pending now from private water users to get 70,000 acre feet of water from the Missouri River and private wells. As development has slowed from the "frantic pace", Harms suggests that perhaps it is time to take a hard look at the funding for WAWS and other services. **When it comes to the taxpayers' money, it never hurts to ask why.**





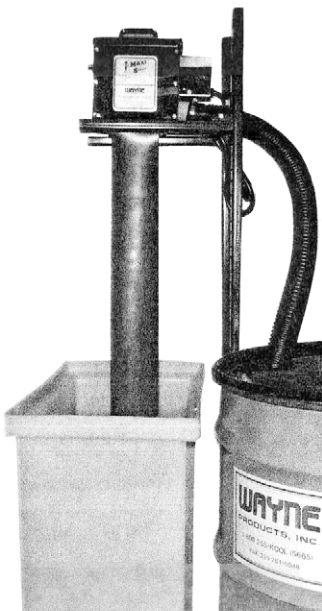
